## **Blue Ribbon Program**



**Purpose:** The Blue-Ribbon program is a way to incentivize providers to submit valid, medically necessary cases for prior authorization review. The program allows high-performing providers to submit non-clinical information when requesting certain prior authorizations. Our algorithms identify providers who have a history of submitting complete and accurate requests for medically necessary services. Providers who meet these criteria will receive auto approval of requests.

## Types of Reviews: All providers for each review type are eligible for the Blue-Ribbon Program

- Physical/Occupational/Speech Therapy over threshold amounts
- Outpatient Behavioral Health Services over threshold amounts
- Home Health Services
- Durable Medical Equipment and Prosthetics and Orthotics
- Skilled Nursing Services for Waiver Plans
- Dental Services including Severe Malocclusion Program
- Surgical Procedures
- Transplants
- Waiver Skilled Nursing Services
- Genetic Testing
- Vision Services
- Unlisted Procedure Codes

## Criteria for the Blue-Ribbon Program

- o 90% approval rate
- 10% or less of Denial + RFI + ONR rate
- o Submit a minimum of 25 reviews per quarter

## **Auditing Process**

\*\*\*\*20% of all requests will be audited each month\*\*\*\*

- 1. Provider will be notified via phone which case did not meet program requirements and a zoom meeting will be set up
- 2. They will be educated on proper submission
- 3. Additional documentation may be requested to ensure the request meets medical necessity
- 4. If the provider fails an audit twice, they may be subject to removal from the program.
